A. GUIDING SYMPTOMS

Let me allow to impress you the Calcarea carb, patient totality through the name of the remedy.

C = Chilly : takes cold readily.

A = Antipsoric : Hahnemann's trio.

L = Leucophlegmatic constitution.

C = Coldness : in general and single parts.

A = Affection of glands : scrofulous & tubercular diathesis.

R = Ravenous hunger.

E = Excessive sour discharges : Sweat, Stool, Vomiting : body smells sour.

A = Assimilation altered : imperfect ossification : delayed mile-stones.

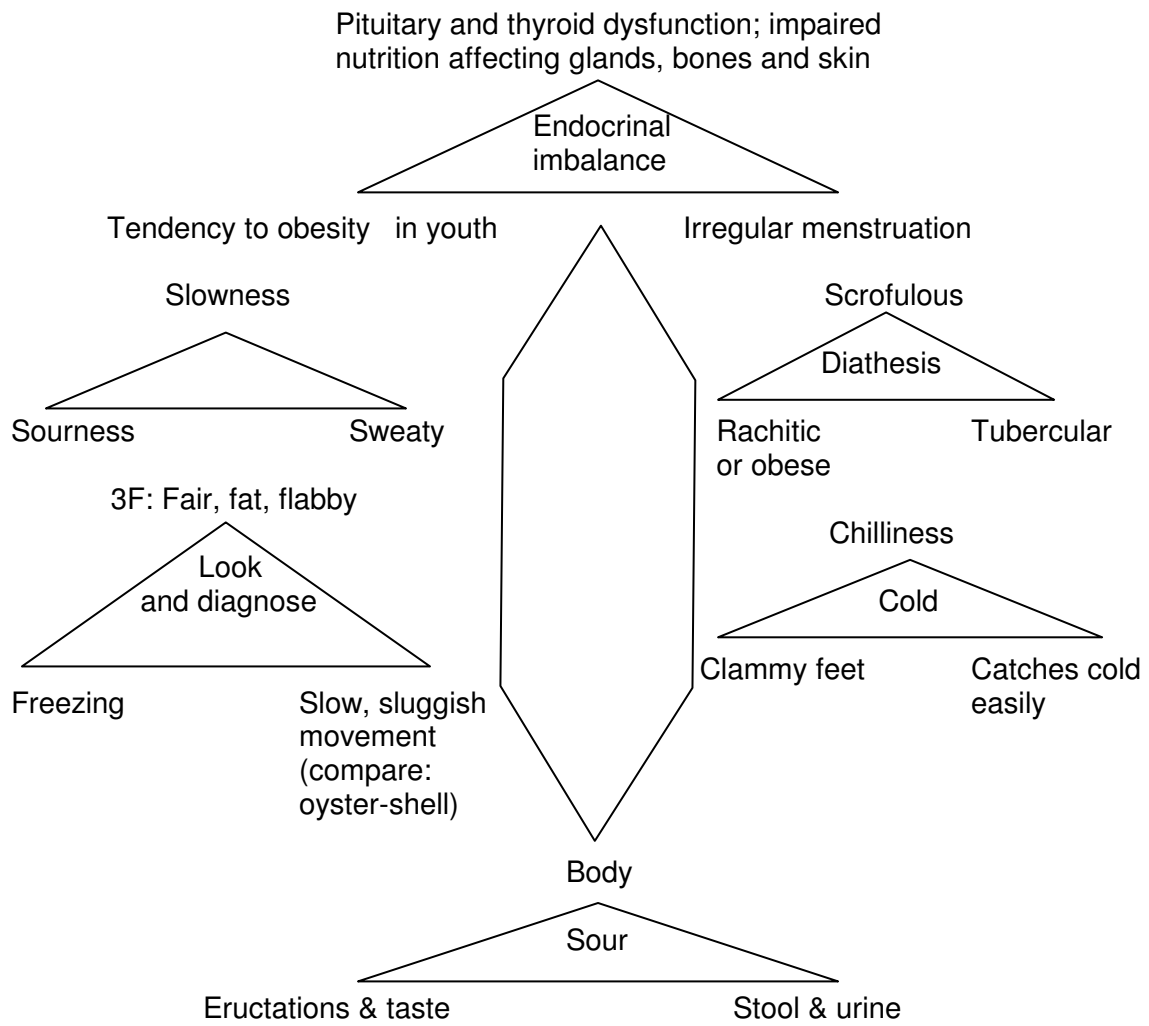
C = Congestion (Ref. Kent).

A = Aversion to meat.

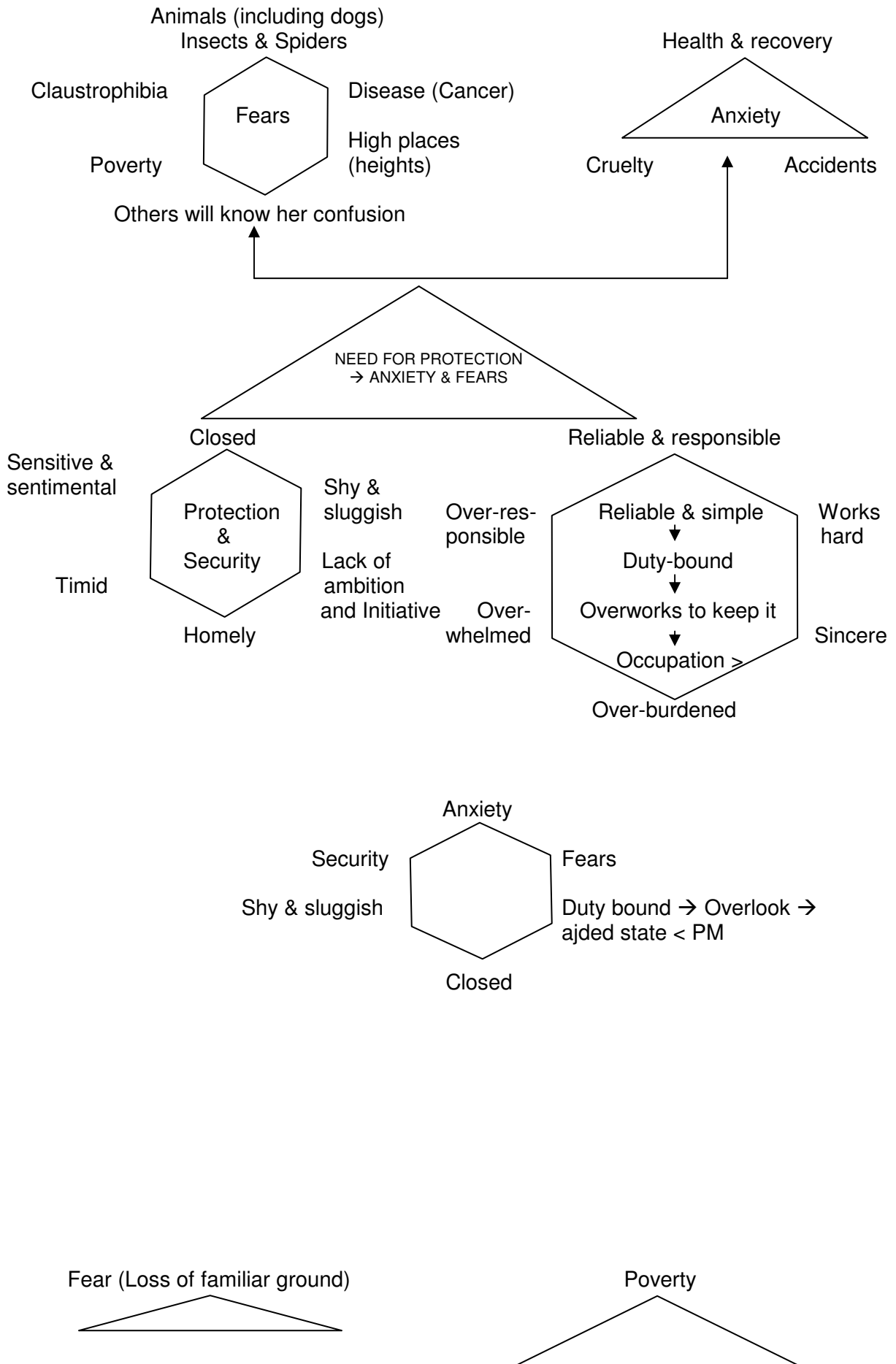
R = Relaxation (Ref. Kent).

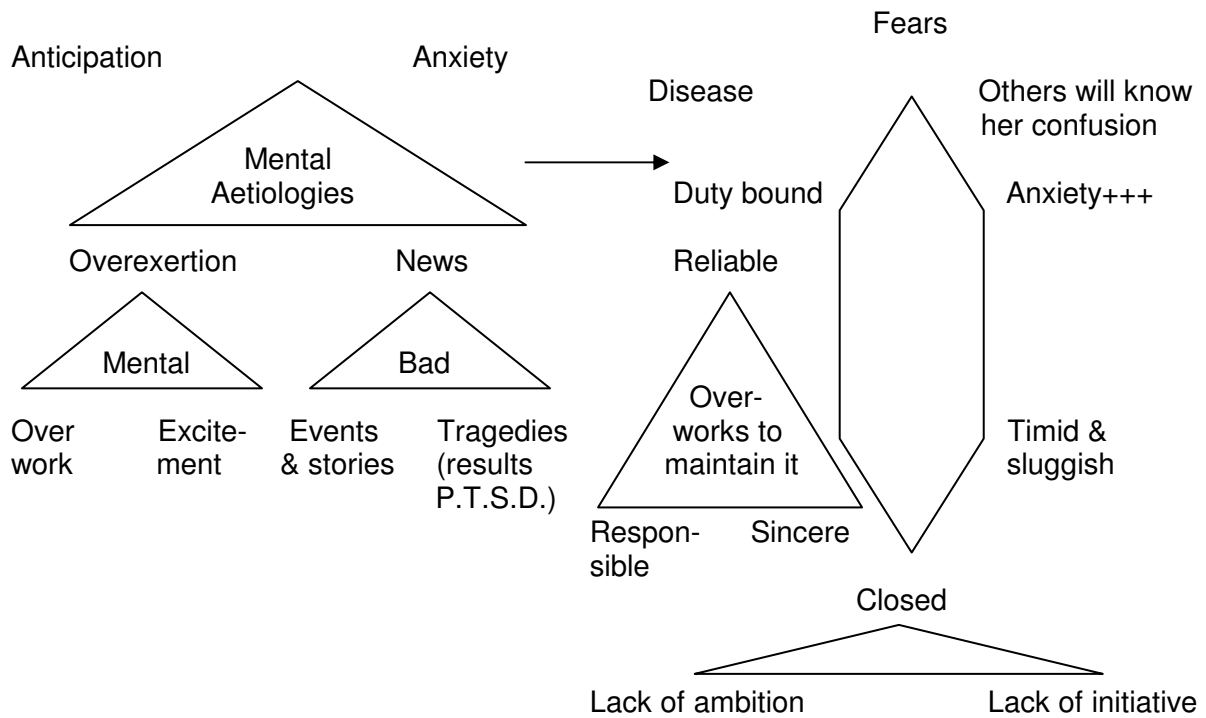
B = Better when constipated.

B. PHYSICAL THEME

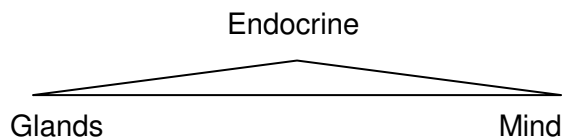


C. MENTAL ESSENCE



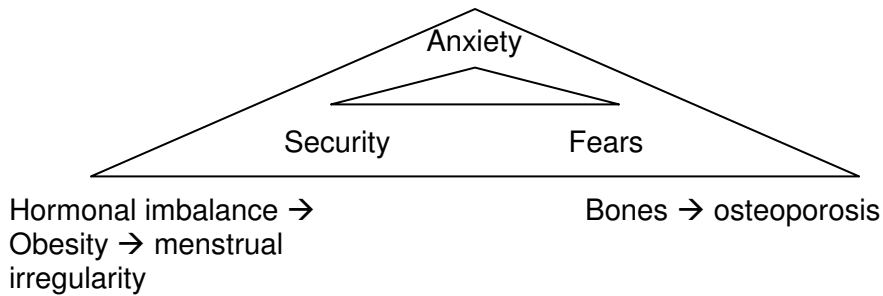


D. SPHERE OF ACTION: WEAKEST LINKS

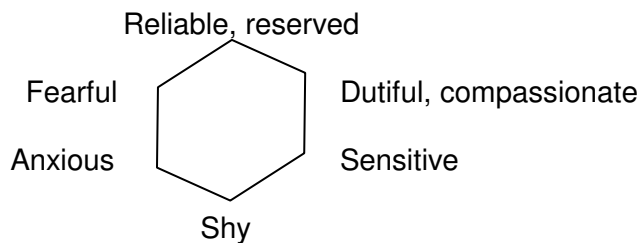


E. CATCH WORDS: KEY NOTES

H. MIASMATICS OF CALCAREA CARB.

Miasmatics : Psora +++, Sycosis +++, Syphilis ++, Tubercular +++

I. OTHER SALTS OF CALCAREA GROUP

(1) CALC. ACETICA & CALC. OXALICA :- Pains of Cancer in Calc. Constitution. (2) CALC. BROMATA :- Cerebral irritation, meningeal symptoms in Calc. Constitution. (3) CALC. CAUSTICA :- Tearing pain intendo achillis; sticking in corns, heel-pains : compresses allays inflammation. (4) CALC. FLUOR :- Bony growths ulceration of bones, fistula, syphilitic periosteal swelling, threatening suppuration a marked indication. (5) CALC. IOD. :- Nodular tumours, movable, tender to touch, painful on moving arms. (6) CALC. OVA TOSTA :- Leucorrhoea with backache, as if broken in two. (7) CALC. PHOS :- Emaciation of Phos & Green, slimy hot stool of Chamo & Weakness of mental stake & inability of mental exertion of Nat. Mur & Sinking sensation in stomachy & prolapse uteri of sepia. Predisposed to glandular & bone disease, scrofulous, gouty constitution. (8) CALC. PICRICA :- Minute and excessively painful boils in meatus, with prostration & fatigue. (9) CALC. RENALIS :- After Berberis in Renal Calculus cases. (10) CALC. SILICA :- Strong syphilitic manifestations (viz. corneal ulcers, atrophy etc.) in Calc. Const. (11) CALC. SULPH :- Suppurative case, after pus has found a vent, which is yellow thick & bumpy (- yellow, serous & profuse cater stages, Kali S; - Sub-act inflammation, fibrinous excudation with white or gray tongue – base coaling, Kali Mur). Calc. Sulph is > in open air (Rev. Heps).
